

How RETAIN works

OPERATIONAL READINESS

Before the incident, knowing you have the required skills available to respond effectively and having the power to change this if not. **Reducing Risk.**



SCHEDULING

Full real time calendar with advanced visibility of the times/ days where there are insufficient people or skills.

Command and control can view easily those registered as available and their skill set (Security, Fire Response Team, Working at Heights, Water Trained Response, Special Operations Response, Hazardous Area Trained Response).

Fill potential shortfalls to remain resilient.



1. ADD YOUR PEOPLE AND ASSIGN THEIR SKILLS

2. SET YOUR EVENTS AND THE SKILLS REQUIRED



3. ADD YOUR PEOPLES AVAILABILITY TO THE SCHEDULE

Full sight of future weakness, to enable proactive measures

Colour-coded to show full skills and your ability to respond to ALL, SOME and NO events

Clear view of your current response status and availability


- Events are shown grouped by Incident type and the skills required.
- Colour coded minute by minute GO/NO GO monitoring.



How RETAIN works

MASS NOTIFICATION

After the Incident - having the ability to notify all responders simultaneously via a DMR Two-way radio, email, workstation alert or smart phone. **Reducing Response Time.**





CREATE AN INCIDENT ALERT

Either enter incident details in the top box or use the drop down menus containing prepopulated locations and incident type.

Select All or choose which team to mobilise.
